




Quarterly Employment

- Total employment in Anchorage increased by 1,600 jobs between the fourth quarter of 2007 and the fourth quarter of 2008, an increase of 1.1 percent. On average, 151,100 workers were employed during the fourth quarter of 2008, based on Alaska Department of Labor and Workforce Development data.
- The largest increases in employment occurred in the business services sector (400 new jobs) and the oil and gas sector (333 new jobs).
- The largest declines in employment occurred in the construction sector (233 fewer jobs) and the leisure and hospitality sector (167 fewer jobs).


Building Permit Values

- Total building permit values, including residential, commercial and government construction, decreased from \$81.2 million in the fourth quarter of 2007 to \$54.9 million in the fourth quarter of 2008, a decrease of approximately 32 percent.
 - Commercial building permit values decreased by 37 percent, from \$48.2 million to \$30.5 million.
 - Residential building permit values decreased by 38 percent, from \$24.6 million to \$15.2 million.
 - Government construction permit values increased by 9.0 percent, from \$8.4 million to \$9.1 million.



Ted Stevens Anchorage International Airport Statistics


- Total passenger deplanements grew by 0.6 percent between the fourth quarter of 2007 and the fourth quarter of 2008.
- The number of passenger aircraft landings dropped by 8.3 percent over the same period.
- The amount of transit cargo passing through Ted Stevens Anchorage International Airport decreased by 30 percent over the same period.



Single Family Housing Unit Sales

- The average sales price of a single family house in Anchorage declined from \$317,841 in the fourth quarter of 2007 to \$310,043 in the fourth quarter of 2008, a decline of 2.5 percent.
- The number of single family housing units sold declined by 10.1 percent over the same period.






Port of Anchorage Annual Tonnage

• Port of Anchorage annual tonnage for 2008 totaled 4.4 million short tons, an increase of 1.0 percent since 2007.


Room Rentals

- Gross revenue from room rentals, an indicator for lodging activity in Anchorage, increased by 10 percent between the fourth quarter of 2007 and the fourth quarter of 2008.
- Taxable revenue from room rentals increased by 19 percent over the same period.



Car and RV Rentals

- Revenue from car and RV rentals, a gauge for visitor activity, increased by 2.9 percent between the fourth quarter of 2007 and the fourth quarter of 2008.
- Tax revenue from car and RV rentals increased by 4.4 percent over the same period.

Consumer Price Index

- The Anchorage Consumer Price Index increased from 183.1 in the second half of 2007 to 191.3 in the second half of 2008, an increase of 4.5 percent.
- The U.S. Consumer Price Index increased by 3.4 percent, from 209.0 to 216.2 over the same time period.

Unemployment Rate

• The Anchorage unemployment rate increased from 4.8 percent in the fourth quarter of 2007 to 5.6 percent in the fourth quarter of 2008, an increase of 0.8 percentage points.
