General Purpose:

Responsible for developing and implementing strategies to improve the economic diversification and strength within the Municipality of Anchorage and the Southcentral region of Alaska through business development, recruitment, entrepreneurship, retention and expansion of businesses and new program development. In collaboration with the Vice President, this important member of the AEDC team will be tasked with:

- Establishing Anchorage and Southcentral Alaska as a viable site for national and international businesses by identifying and building relationships with leading site selection consultants and U.S. and foreign owned corporations to communicate the benefits of location and/or relocation of businesses to Southcentral Alaska.
- Actively promote sites and business opportunities within the City of Anchorage and the Southcentral region that will develop new quality commercial and industrial projects in partnership with local businesses, agencies, developers, property agents and owners.
- Research, develop and market targeted economic incentives to increase the attractiveness of Anchorage and the Southcentral region for new business investments.
- Collaborates with key staff to develop and implement public relations strategies for projects that promote economic development within the region.
- Engage businesses and startups to provide business consulting, assistance with securing funding, promotion and networking opportunities to help them grow.
- Participates in select industry trade shows to generate direct leads.
- Provides input on the development of strategies that impact the region's ability to attract and retain businesses.
- Collaborates with other economic development organizations and agencies to leverage the strengths of AEDC with the strengths of others to the benefit of the Anchorage and Alaska economies.
- Identify and secure grant and other funding for expanding existing economic development projects that allow the organization to grow.
- Organize, execute and compile research for internal and contracted research projects.
