

Anchorage GDP By Economic Sector








Anchorage Single Family Home Total Unit Sales










2019 BCI - Top 10 Barriers to Business Growth



Anchorage Population Forecast 2007-2018, 2019 forecast





ANC Oil & Gas Employment & Alaska North Slope price per barrel 2007-2018 and 2019 forecast







2006-2018 and 2019 forecast





Anchorage Transportation Employment 2007-2018 and 2019 forecast







Anchorage Professional & Business Services 2007-2018, and 2019 forecast







Anchorage Leisure & Hospitality Employment 2007-2018 and 2019 forecast





2007-2018 and 2019 forecast





Anchorage Financial Activities Employment 2007-2018 and 2019 forecast





- 2019 will likely mark the end of a four-year recession in Anchorage with a modest net 300 new jobs added by year-end.
- Continued growth in healthcare, transportation and the visitor industry, combined with recent upticks in construction and the improving outlook for professional services and retail are causes for optimism
- While economic conditions are improving, the end of the recession is not a recovery
- Lack of a firm state fiscal plan remains a significant risk to growth and investment


